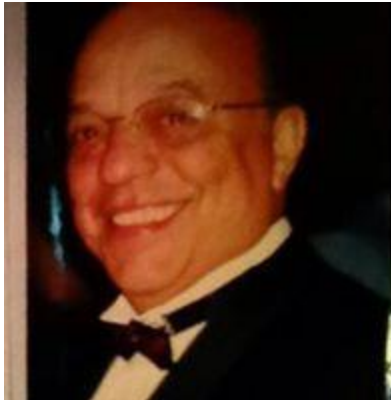


Samir N Banoob, M.D, D.M, DPH, Ph.D
