Founder and the first chief of Chair of Social Medicine (1994) and founder and the first director of Institute of Social Medicine (1998) within the Faculty of Medicine (FM) in Skopje. Driving force for establishing Center/ School of Public Health (2003) and developing MPH and PhD study curricula in Public Health at the FM-Skopje. He got Dr.Sc. (PhD) Degree in early 1993 and realized one-year postdoctoral studies in public health (Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program) at the Emory University SPH in Atlanta, USA (1993/94). Full-time Professor in social medicine and public health at the FM-Skopje since 2003. As a national counterpart of WHO contributed for preparing the European Strategy and Action Plan for Prevention and Control of NCDs and related documents in R. Macedonia. Since 2000 actively participated in a broad scope of educational and research activities within the Stability Pact PH-SEE project. Editor-in-Chief for Public Health of the Open Access Mac J Med Sci and Co-Editor-in-Chief of *Materia Soc Med*, as well as a member of the Editorial Board of numerous scientific journals. Editor and author/coauthor of a number of textbooks, monographs and books, author of more than 300 articles, book chapters and papers presented and published in Proceedings and peer-review journals in biomedicine.
