

## **Prof. Fimka Tozija**



Professor Fimka Tozija is a Policy Adviser at the Institute of Public Health, Head of the Department for Injury and Violence Control and Prevention, and Head of the Department for Social Medicine (at her alma mater) at the Faculty of Medicine of The Saints Cyril and Methodius University of Skopje. She has been working in public health policy and practice, especially in the field of social medicine, healthcare systems and management, health economics, health statistics, injury and violence research and safety promotion. She has participated in international projects on health and social inclusion policies with WHO, UNICEF, UNDP, UNFPA, CDC etc. and has contributed to over 200 peer-reviewed publications. She worked for seven years as component coordinator and health specialist on a collaborative project with the World Bank. She was awarded by Macedonian Medical Association with Certificate of Honor. She is also actively engaged in health policy at the international level through her work on several committees, including the Council of Europe's Committee of Experts on Migrant Health, COST Management Committees, Board of Directors of the Road Traffic Injury Research Network and member of the WHO European Advisory Committee on Health Research. She is also the national focal point for WHO network for violence and injury prevention, Coordinator of the Safe Community Affiliate Support Centre and associate coordinator of the SEEHN Regional Health Development Centre for public health in Skopje.
